



Eddington Place HOA Swimming Pool Rules

The Eddington Place HOA pool is a neighborhood amenity for use by its members, tenants and their guests only. To use the pool Members must be current in all dues. Members are also responsible for tenant actions. Key fobs are required for entry and may NOT be shared with non-members or with members whose privileges have been revoked. Season opening and closing dates will be provided via email and Facebook.

Pool Hours: The pool is open daily from 10am to 10pm with the exception of Tuesdays when it is closed for cleaning, maintenance and private parties (**private parties must end by 9pm**). The pool will be for **adults only** from 5am to 10am.

NO LIFEGUARDS – ENTER WATER AT YOUR OWN RISK

1. Climbing on and jumping over the gate and / or the fence around the property is considered trespassing and vandalism. To discourage this behavior before, during and after hours, a \$50 fine will be assessed.
2. **Children under the age of 14 MUST be supervised by a parent or a responsible guardian at all times.** Children under age three (3) MUST have a parent or responsible guardian with them in the water at all times. A guardian MUST be at least 18 years of age. The parent approved guardian is responsible for their young child (children) at all times. Members should determine the skill level of their people before they enter the pool.
3. All alcoholic beverages, tobacco products or controlled substances are strictly prohibited in or around the pool area. All persons under the influence of alcohol or drugs will be restricted from the entire pool facility.
4. ONLY swim suits are to be worn in the pool. NO cut-off and/or street clothing allowed. Attire should not be extremely revealing.
5. Babies and all non potty trained children MUST wear a swim diaper. If feces are found in the pool, immediately notify one of the HOA board members.
6. Anyone with open wounds, bandages or symptoms of communicable diseases is not permitted in the water.
7. NO diving, running, pushing, scuffling, rough play, profanity or abusive language in the pool area at any time.
8. **NO PETS** – not even on a leash.
9. **NO loud music.** Headphones must be used. Consideration should be given not to disturb others in the pool area and those living in surrounding houses.
10. **NO glass containers of any kind.**
11. NO open flames or grills permitted inside the pool gates. Food and drinks MUST be kept at least six (6) feet away from the pool.
12. All pool furniture must remain in the pool area and no other furniture may be brought in.

13. Limit guests to five (5) per household and accompany them to the pool. Residents are responsible for informing their guests of the rules and having an active key fob.
14. Park all bicycles and wheeled vehicles, skates and skateboards etc. outside the pool area and away from the front gate and sidewalk.
15. Keep the gate closed and locked at all times.
16. Shower before entering the pool. Remove all excess body lotions before entering the water.
17. In an emergency dial 911 on the telephone on the pool house wall. If the phone gets accidentally removed from the hook, pick it up, stay on the line and let the 911 operator know this is NOT an emergency otherwise the police WILL dispatch an officer to investigate.
18. Place all litter in the trash containers provided.
19. Take your articles with you – your towels, books, toys, etc.
20. What about a lost, stolen or damaged key fob? Please report it to a HOA board member.
Key Card Replacement cost is \$25

NOTE:

- Eddington Place HOA swimming Pool Rules may be modified at any time by the HOA board as the need arises.
- The Association and/or its representatives have the right to evict anyone from the pool area at any time
- The board may also take action to suspend the use of the pool for violations of these rules by way of verbal and / or written warning, temporary suspension from the pool, and / or dismissal from the pool for the remainder of the season – without any refund.
- As a member you are responsible for the cost of repairs due to damage caused by your family, tenants or guests. This includes any incident which requires the pool to be drained, filled and chemically balanced.
